PARENT PROGRAM:

A core part of Running River is our Parent Program. This includes the following requirements for each family (at least one adult per family):

- attending parent forums once a month (meetings are held on the third Thursday of each month from 5-7 pm; dinner and child care are provided)
- participating in the classroom four hours per month either in a one hour block once a week or a four hour block once a month
- actively participating in school fundraising efforts

MEAL POLICY:

Running River School is pleased to offer our students all natural, homemade and primarily organic lunches M-TR. On these days we ask that you provide your child/children **ONLY** with a fruit or vegetable side and a beverage. Providing additional foods to your child disrupts the intention of teaching our students about simple, nourishing, shared meals. On Fridays students bring their own sack lunch to facilitate their outdoor activity schedule. Running River can accommodate some food sensitivities and food allergies.

CAMPING TRIPS:

Two camping trips take place each year. In the fall the older children go on a five day trip. Parents are welcome but not required to attend. This trip is important in establishing an invaluable connection within the group and introducing the main ideas of study for the year. There is an additional cost for this trip and the cost varies. In the spring the whole school goes camping at Rocky Mountain National Park. We ask that at least one adult from every family be present; siblings are welcome. In some cases another family may be asked to care for a child if his/her parent(s) or guardian(s) cannot attend.
